# Warren County Farmers Fair Pet of the Year- NEW IN 2023

## **Rules and Regulations:**

1. The exhibitor must own the pet or it be in the immediate family of the exhibitor.

2. Proof of up-to-date rabies vaccine is REQUIRED for cats and dogs. The tag or record MUST match the pet and be shown during registration.

3. Pet MUST be in good health, free of parasites (fleas, ticks, etc)

4. Exhibitors MUST clean up after their pet and relieve them in non-public areas.

5. Pet MUST be under control of the exhibitor at all times.

6. Cats and dogs MUST be leashed/harnessed or in a suitable carrier while waiting to show in the ring.

7. Small animals MUST be in carriers, cages, leashed or harnessed while waiting to show in the ring.

8. Livestock pets MUST be harnessed while waiting to show in the ring and during showing. They MUST be trained for public settings.

9. NO PET can be left unattended in a vehicle while parked at fairgrounds.

10. Committee members reserve the right to disqualify any pet for health, behavior, or any other reason deemed dangerous or necessary for the protections of the public and other animals.

11. Committee members reserve the right to cancel or combine classes due to participation. Number of participants may be limited depending entries.

12. Exhibitors will pay entry to enter the fairgrounds and pet(s) will be granted entry at no charge as long as the fairgoer is entering the pet(s) into the show.

\*Small animals/livestock pets include but are not limited to pet guinea pigs, rabbits, birds, hamsters, reptiles, chinchillas, cattle, pigs, goats, ponies, horses, sheep, etc. Pet must not be deemed dangerous or a threat to the public.
