A trophy will be awarded to the best entry in each class. Best of Show - \$20.00 and a rosette and trophy

Rules

- 1. All farmers are eligible to enter. The sample must have been grown by the exhibitor in 2024.
- 2. Only one sample from the same farm will be accepted for entry in each class.
- 3. Entry Procedure: Samples should be identified with name, mailing address, cutting number, and class. Please fill out entry tag and attach securely to each entry BEFORE DELIVERY TO THE FAIRGROUNDS. Please call 908-475-6505 to request additional tags.
- 4. An entry shall consist of an undisturbed compact bale section AT LEAST 12" THICK.

Regulations

- 1. All hays will be judged according to their ideals, regardless of time of cutting, number of cuttings or procedure in harvesting, other than curing. Important factors to be considered are leafiness (percent of leaves), amount of green color, and percentage of foreign material (weeds, etc.).
- 2. Hay classification will be at the show Chairman's discretion.
- 3. Pure grass hays are not to contain more than 10% legumes.
- 4. Please check your entries for a "trophy card". Trophies can be picked up at the FAIR OFFICE until Saturday, August 3rd or at the EXTENSION OFFICE in Belvidere starting Monday, August 5th.

Classes

Alfalfa Group

- 1. Alfalfa, first cutting alfalfa with less than 10% grass
- 2. Alfalfa, later cutting alfalfa with less than 10% grass

Mixed Alfalfa/Grass Group

- 3. Alfalfa with grass, first cutting any grass hay and alfalfa that contains approximately 50% grass
- 4. Alfalfa with grass, later cutting any grass hay and alfalfa that contains approximately 50% grass

Clover Group

- 5. Clover, first cutting clover with less than 10% grass
- 6. Clover with grass, first cutting any species of grass and clover mixed hay that contains approximately 50% clover
- 7. Clover with grass, later cutting any species of grass and clover mixed hay that contains approximately 50% clover

Grass Group

- 8. Timothy, first cutting timothy containing less than 10% alfalfa or clover
- 9. Orchard grass, first cutting orchard grass containing less than 10% alfalfa or clover
- 10. Brome, first cutting brome containing less than 10% alfalfa or clover
- 11. Mixed grass, first cutting two or more species of grass, equally mixed, containing less than 10% clover or alfalfa
- 12. Grass, later cutting pure species or a mixture of grasses containing less than 10% clover or alfalfa

Straw

- 13. Oat straw
- 14. Barley straw
- 15. Rye straw
- 16. Wheat straw

A trophy will be awarded to the best entry in classes 1 through 3, and Best of Show.

Rules

- 1. Use one (1) quart, wide mouth glass fruit jars for exhibit. One jar comprises an entry.
- 2. More than one entry may be made by an individual, but each entry must be from a different silo.
- 3. Please fill out entry tag and attach securely to each entry BEFORE DELIVERY TO THE FAIRGROUNDS. Please call 908-475-6505 to request additional tags.
- 4. Entries will be judged on the following basis:
 - Odor 45 points, Appearance 35 points, Mold 20 points.
- 5. Please check your entries for a "trophy card". Trophies can be picked up at the FAIR OFFICE until Saturday, August 3rd or at the EXTENSION OFFICE in Belvidere starting Monday, August 5th.
