- Entries to be postmarked by July 19th
- Entries Postmarked July 20th until close of check in for respective shows are an additional \$10/head
- No Refunds
- Market animals, commercial does and Jr. breeding sheep are open to any youth 21 and under as of January 1st, 2024
- Breeding Sheep, including commercial meat and wool animals, are open to all exhibitors
- Leased breeding animals may be shown with proper 4-H and/or breed association paperwork along with a copy of the animals registration papers if applicable
- Exhibitors can exhibit as many animals as they choose- no cap on entries
- Market lambs, Market Goats and Commercial Does will show off the trailers- unless pens are available.
- Pens provided for breeding sheep for preregistered animals first then as available for all others.
- No camper hook ups are available
- No power in trailer parking- please bring your own generator if you need power
- Showers will be available

Showmanship

- Open to all youth exhibitors, both breeding and market
- Entry Fee: \$5/per exhibitor, per species until July 19th, \$10/per exhibitor from July 20th until close of check in.
- Exhibitors will be split into classes based on age as of January 1st, 2023

Market Goats -Youth Show Only

- Show is open to does and wethers
- Goats must have a full set of kid's teeth
- Animals cannot cross enter into commercial does
- Entry Fee: \$25/head until July 19th, \$35/head from July 20th until close of scales
- Entries will be broken into weight classes

Commercial Does – Youth Show Only

- Open to yearling and Doe kids- will be split up by weight
- Animals cannot cross enter into market goat classes
- Entry Fee: \$10/head until July 19th, \$20/head from July 20th until close of scales

Market Lambs – Youth Show Only

- Show is open to ewes and wethers
- Lambs must have a full set of lamb's teeth
- Market lambs cannot cross enter in breeding/ commercial ewe show
- Entry Fee: \$25/head until July 19th, \$35/head from July 20th until close of scales
- Lambs will be broken by breed then weight (pending entry numbers):
 - Breeds will be classified at the scales
 - Breeds must have at least 5 lambs and 3 exhibitors to have a division or be a sponsored breed
 - Breed Sponsors are \$100 per breed

Breeding Sheep

- Breeding animals cannot cross enter breeds or into market lamb show
- Entry Fees:
 - Open: \$10/head and \$5 for best fleece July 19th, \$20/ head and \$15 for best fleece July 20th until close of check in
 - Youth: \$5/ head no extra fees for best fleece July 19th, \$15/head from July 20th until close of check in
 - **Youth entering both open and youth divisions must pay entry fees for both**
- One entry per exhibitor in best fleece class per breed
- Pens will be available for sheep and assigned based on pre-entries received.
- Commercial Meat and Commercial wool will have their own breed shows
- For a breed show a breed must have at least 5 animals and 3 exhibitors (combined youth and open) or be sponsored
 - Breed sponsorship is \$150 per Breed
- Classes offered per breed:
 1. Yearling ram
 2. Fall Ram Lamb (born 9/1/23 -12/31/23)
 3. Spring Ram Lamb (born on or after Jan 1, 2024)
 4. Pair of Ram Lambs
 5. Aged Ewes
 6. Pair of Aged Ewes
 7. Yearling Ewe
 8. Pair of yearling Ewes
 9. Fall Ewe Lambs (born 9/1/23-12/31/23)
 - 10.Spring ewe lambs (born on or after Jan 1,2024)
 - 11.Pair of ewe lambs
 - 12.Pair of lambs any sex
 - 13.Small Flock (2 ewes and 1 ram any age)
 - 14.Best Fleece- wool breeds

- Market Goats/ Lambs -\$25/head
- Commercial Does- \$10/head
- Open Breeding -\$10/head
 - Group classes/ Fleece-\$5/class
- Youth Breeding Sheep -\$5/head
- Showmanship- \$5/exhibitor (per species)

From July 20th to Close of Check in (Post Marked Date)

- Market Goats/Lambs -\$35/head (until close of scales)
- Commercial Does- \$20/head (until close of scales)
- Open breeding- \$10/head (until check-in closes)
 - Group classes/ fleece-\$15/class
- Youth Breeding sheep -\$15 /head (until check-in closes)
- Showmanship- \$10/head (until 30 minutes prior to scheduled show start)

Premium:

Breed/Type Classes: The following prize money will be awarded in each breed class by the Warren County Farmers Fair Association. Checks will be mailed.

Open Show Premiums - \$20 – First, \$15 – Second, \$10 – Third, \$8 – Fourth, \$5 – Fifth.

Youth Show Premiums - \$10- First, \$8 – Second, \$6 – Third, \$5 – Fourth, \$3- Fifth

Market Classes - 1st Place \$30, 2nd Place \$20

Grand Champion Market Lamb/Goat- \$50 and award

Reserve Champion Market Lamb/Goat - \$25 and award
